

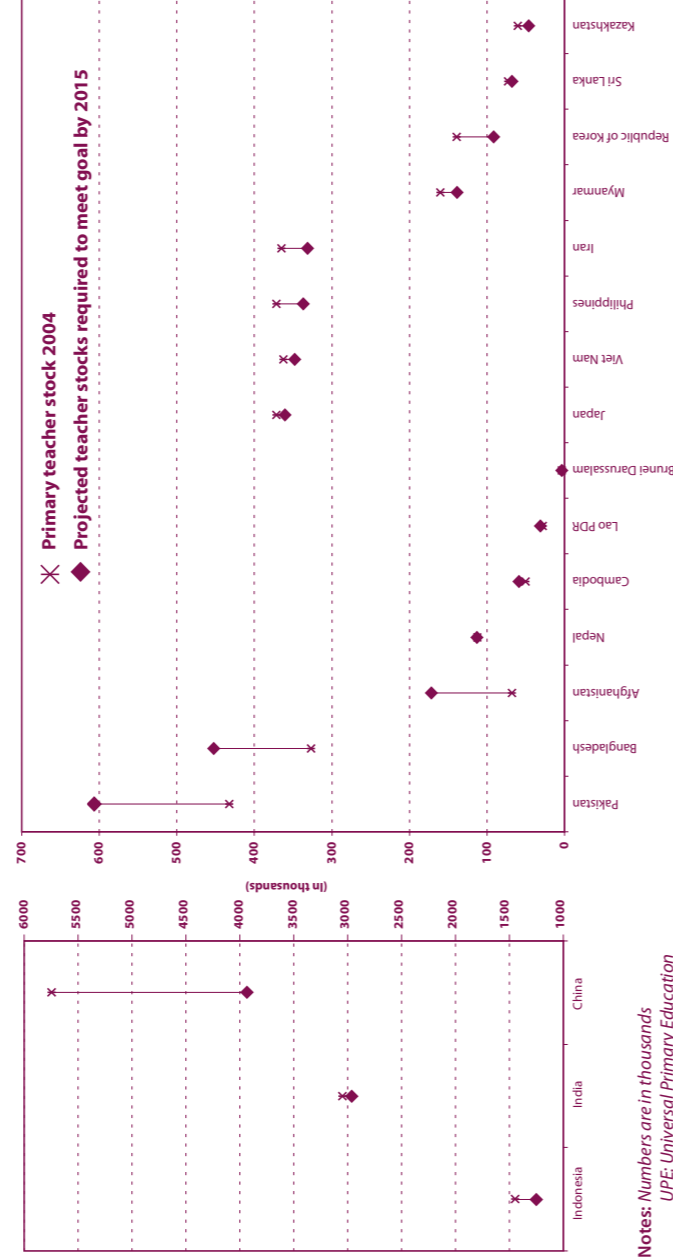

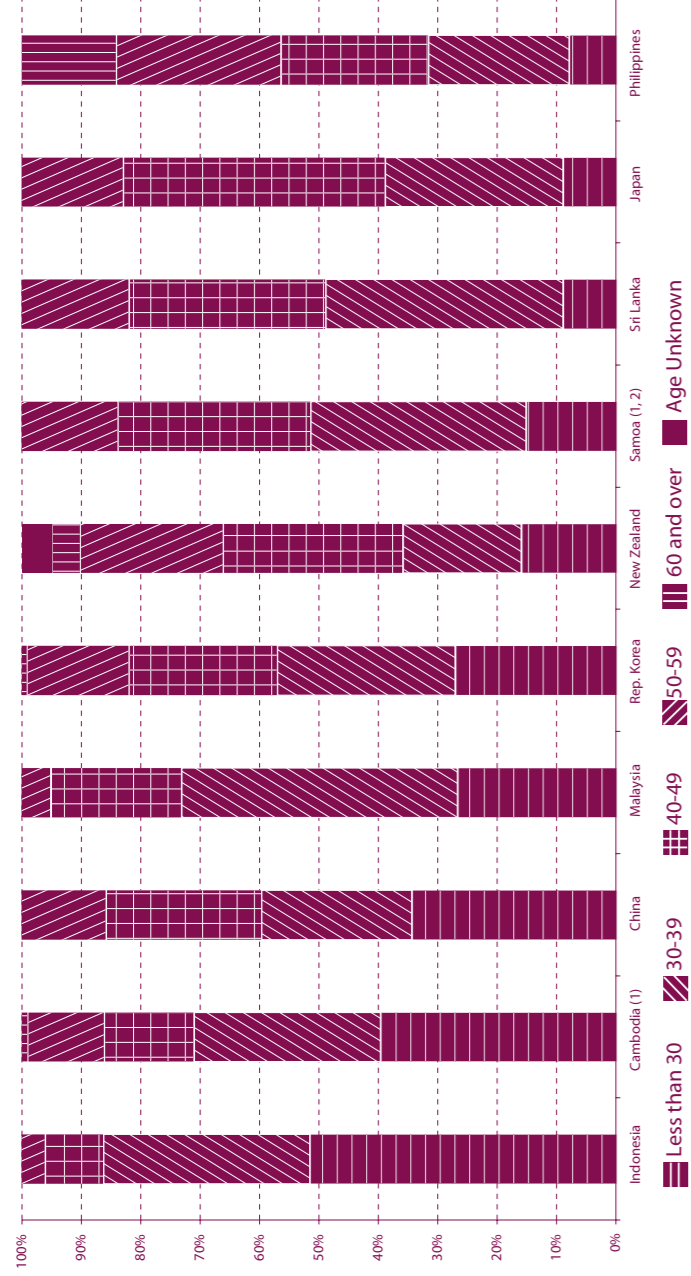

Primary Teachers by Age Group (2002-2003) (Selected Countries)



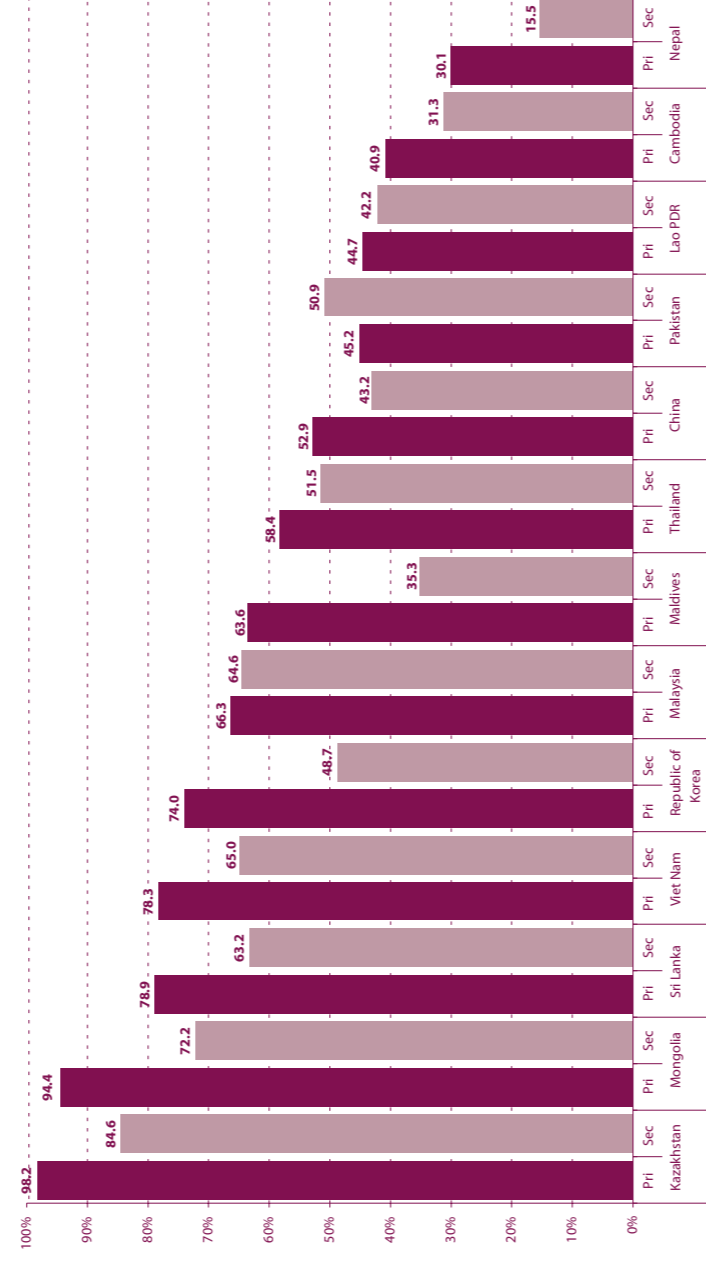

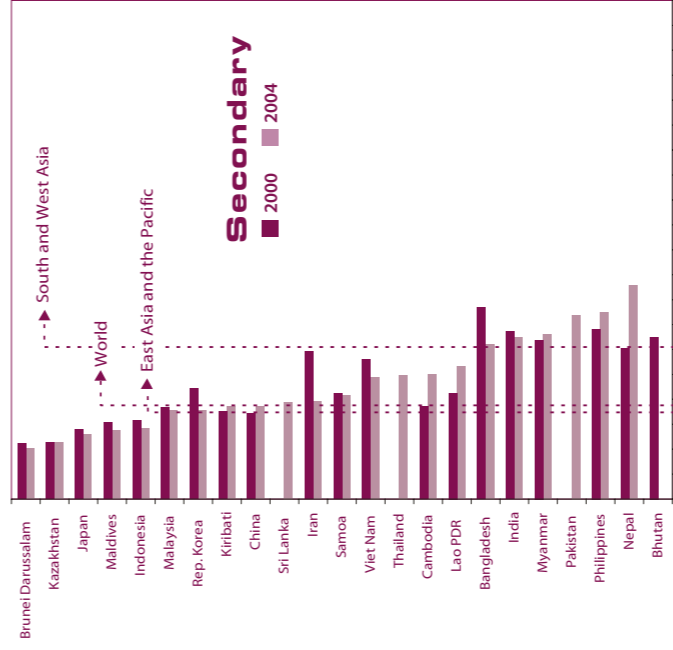
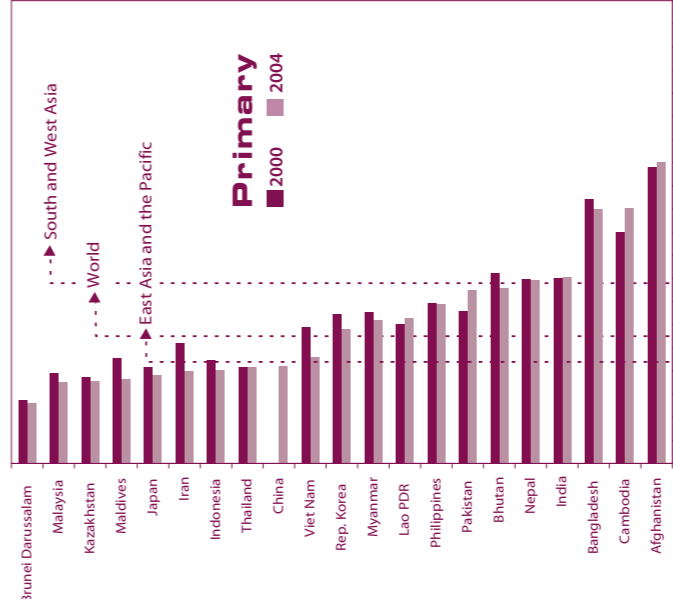

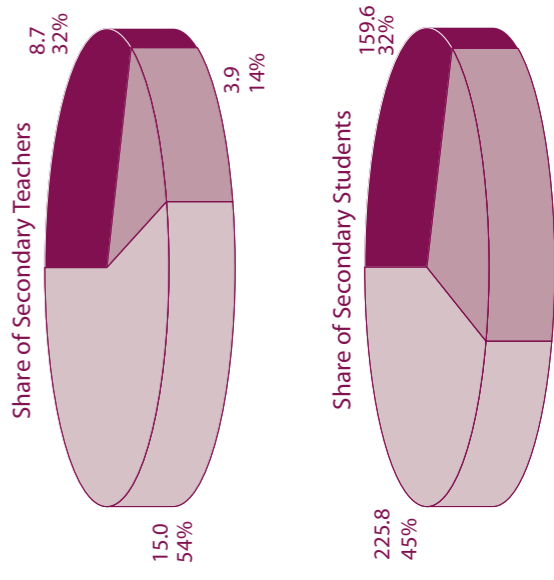
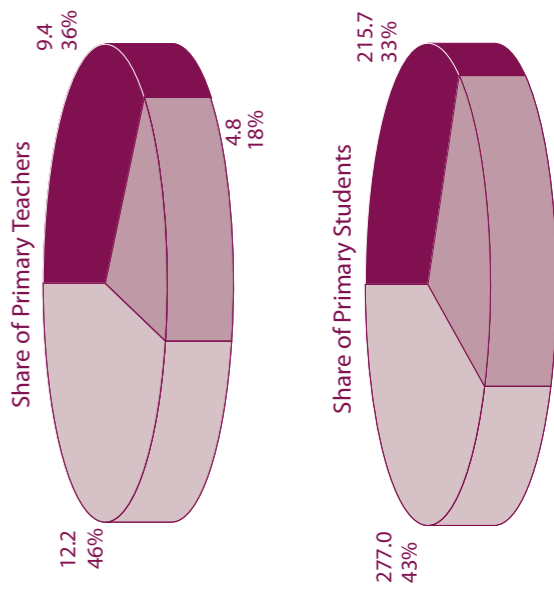
Pupil-Teacher Ratios (Selected Countries)
